COMMUNITY HURRICANE RESPONSE

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Have your family's response plan in place including evacuation plans in the event evacuations are ordered by authorities.
- No response plan? Get help at www.FloridaDisaster.org
- Know your evacuation zone. The majority of the Bayou Club is located in either evacuation zones A or B. To find your evacuation level call 727-453-3150.
- Consult www.pinellascounty.org/emergency for Emergency Management phone numbers and Hurricane Information.
- In the event a Hurricane Watch is issued: Hurricane conditions could occur within 36 hours. A hurricane watch should trigger your disaster plan.
- In the event a Hurricane Warning is issued: Winds of at least 74 MPH are expected within 24 hours. Your family's proactive response should be in its' completion stages.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT BCCA RESPONSE:

- Preparations by the office staff will commence in advance of Hurricane Watch conditions. Association records will be transferred to a secure offsite storage facility. Office computers, printers and other electronic equipment will be secured.
- Weiser Security Officers will remain onsite until winds reach 45 MPH threshold or evacuation is ordered. Guardhouse equipment will be secured in advance of Hurricane Watch conditions.
- Gate arms will be removed and swing gates will be set to the open position to allow for evacuation in the event it becomes necessary whether or not there is power failure.
- Administrative and Security Staff will return to the property as soon as it is deemed safe to do so.
- Access to the property will be controlled and the gates will be put back into service as soon as possible. BCCA staff will conduct damage assessment to common elements and initiate contact with appropriate vendors as required.
